*This includes prepayments of annual pledges of \$14,166.67 for pledges September - December, 2024.

**This takes into accounts no endowment/scholarship accounts being used in unrestricted income.

***Additionally, a \$15,000 endowment pull was done, but currently has raised \$12,204.20 to offset for parish projects/air conditioning of restricted income.

NOTE - an additional \$15,000 from the newly reallocated Thrift Shop Account was approved to pay needed expenses in September.
